- Camping is for paying festival-goers only. Access to all campers will only be via tickets, available on the entry gate.
- Please leave a contact number and register their vehicle registration number (if kept in the camping field) at the entry gate.
- Every under 17-year-old MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult OVER the age of 25. For your own safety, you will be challenged if you arrive or stay without an accompanying adult.
- No vehicle movement will be allowed after 10pm and before 7am apart from in an emergency
- No vehicle stereos or amplified music will be allowed in the camping area.

We would like to remind ALL visitors to the Ashcott Beer Fest that dogs are not allowed at the event. Well behaved dogs are, however, welcome in the campsite, but please make sure that you pick up any mess and that they are not left in hot cars etc.
